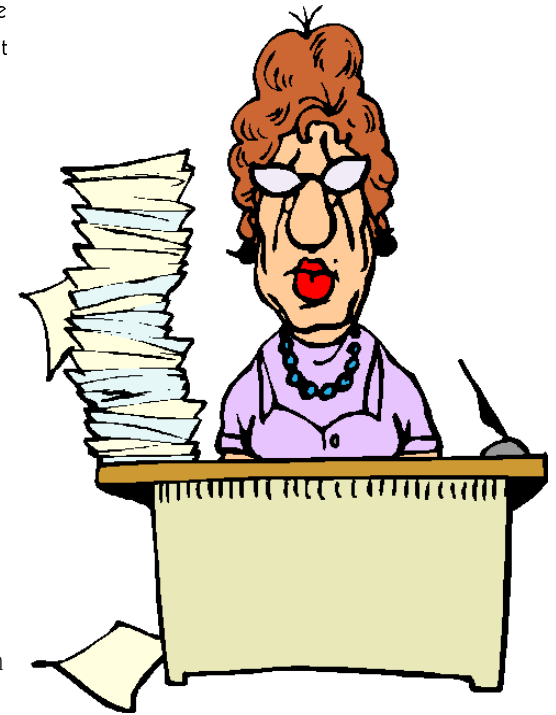
"You were made to be."
