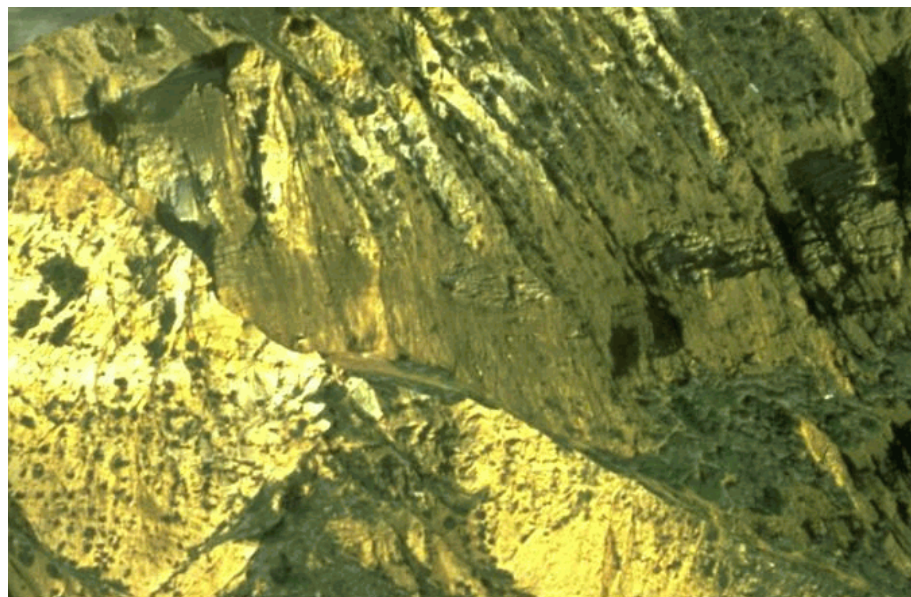

The word *lent* probably referred to the lengthening of the day, and
originally connoted spring. Lent is not mentioned in the Holy Bible. It became a
church season about the fourth century as a period of fasting and penitence
during the forty days between Ash Wednesday and Easter eve, a time to recall the
forty days Jesus spent in the wilderness preparing himself for his ministry.
