Celebrate Recovery

Celebrate Recovery is a Christ-centered ministry for anyone who has a hurt, hang-up, or habit that he wishes to be free from. You don't need to be addicted to something to benefit from Celebrate Recovery

When Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit after He had been tempted in the wilderness, He went to Nazareth where he had been brought up. On the Sabbath day he went into the synagogue, and he stood up to read. The scroll of the prophet Isaiah was handed to him. Unrolling it, he found the place where it is written: (Isaiah 61:1-3) "The Spirit of the Sovereign LORD is on me, because the LORD has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners, to proclaim the year of the LORD's favor and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn, and provide for those who grieve in Zion—to bestow on them a crown of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of gladness instead of mourning, and a garment of praise instead of a spirit of despair. They will be called oaks of righteousness, a planting of the LORD for the display of his splendor."

For Jesus to pick that verse to kick off His ministry, healing and recovery must have been very high on His priority list.

Jesus has the same heart for healing and recovery today as he did then, so pray about attending Celebrate Recovery as soon as another class opens.
