The worship center at 171 East Center Street is called "Be Church", and the facility at 131 South State Street is referred to as "The Be".

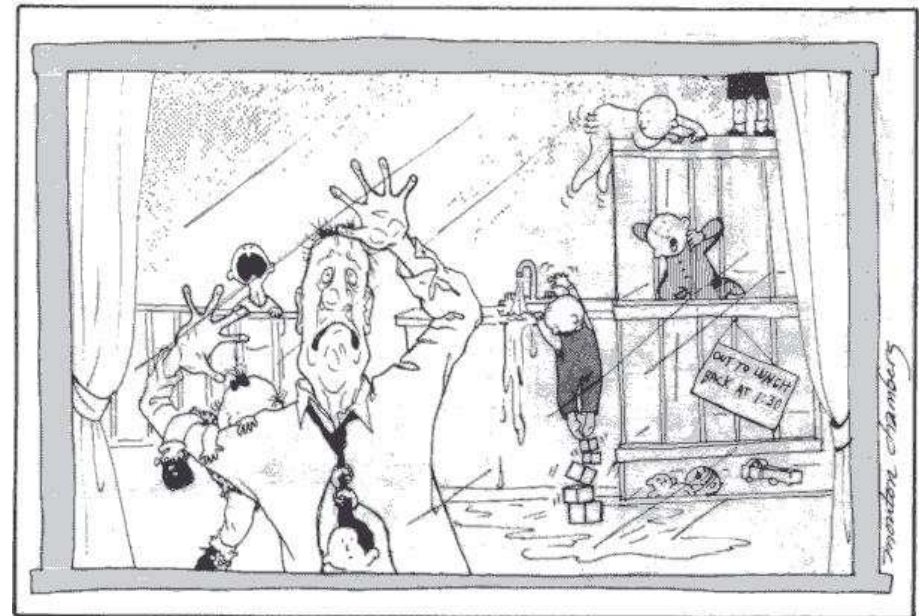
