have died.

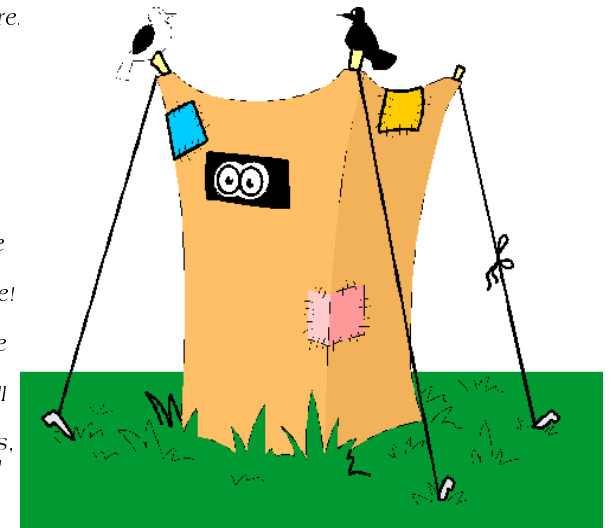
They are here and things have

Christ our Savior will say, "Come up here!"

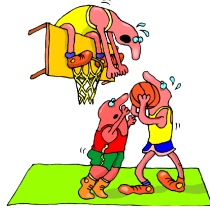
Then in that fair city with streets of gold,
