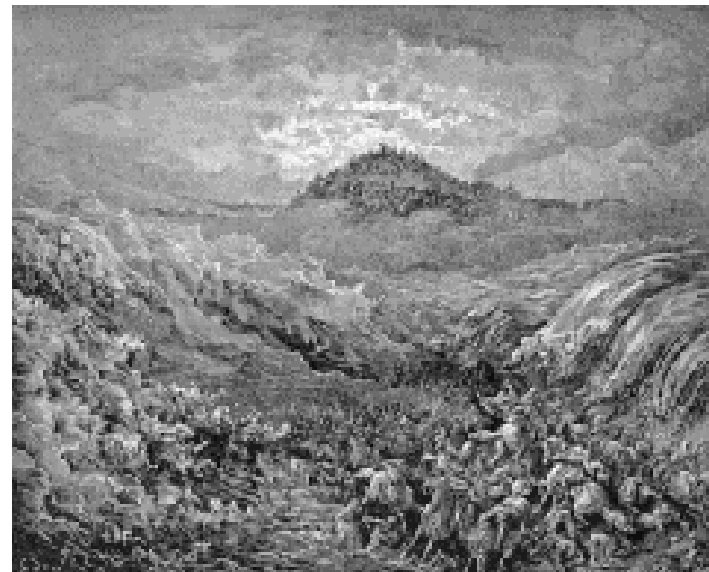

## What did the Israelites do?

To refresh your memory, read Exodus 14 and 15. Pay particular attention to verses 1 through 21 of chapter 15. ***They praised God!***

These two chapters illustrate only one example of what the leadership has been trying to impress upon us: God delivered His people in the past, and He is still on the throne. ***Trust Him! Praise Him!***
